## Blast from the Past

**Forty-five Years Ago:** Officers for the coming year were to be installed and final preparations for the Show to be held at Shepherds Mall later in the month. The Annual Show of the Oklahoma Chapter of the National Woodcarvers Association (*also known as the Oklahoma City Woodcarvers Club*) was featured on WKY-TV on the “Danny’s Day” program.

**Fifteen Years Ago:** A look back at OCWC’s history shows that in June, 1999, Bob Smith presented the program on how to use clay to help design woodcarvings. It was also announced that the Annual Show would be in October for the first time but would still be held at Quail Springs Mall. The newsletter also announced the names of those offering purchase awards which had reached a total of \$1,600. Donations to acquire a purchase award to be given as a door prize reached \$50.

A delegation of over ten members arrived early on a May morning to help remove Catalpa trees from a park in Mustang. Bob Smith arranged to have woodcarvers carry away as many logs as they liked, and many pickups were filled with prime carving wood, all free of charge.

**Ten Years Ago:** The membership approved a revision to the By-Laws changing the “Honorary Membership” from a life membership to a truly honorary award to an individual who is not a member and has performed an outstanding service to the Club. Such membership to now be for a period of one year. The change eliminated the life membership provision from the previous By-Laws.
