Members congregate weekly at various locations to carve, visit, and help newer carvers. Some of these are; MWC Sr. Center – Monday pm, Woodson Park – Wednesday am, 1st Baptist Church – Thursday am, Edmond Sr. Center – Thursday pm, Church of the Servant – Wednesday evening.

### Events

'*Artistry in Wood*' is the Club's annual show and sale held on a weekend late in October at the Hobbies, Arts and Crafts Building on the Oklahoma State Fairgrounds. '*Artistry in Wood*' is open to the public, and brings local and regional artisans works of art in wood, to be judged, put on display, and sold. Various seminars & demonstrations will be held to educate and entertain both adults and youth. The Club sponsors other seminars taught by club members and artists invited from outside of Oklahoma.
