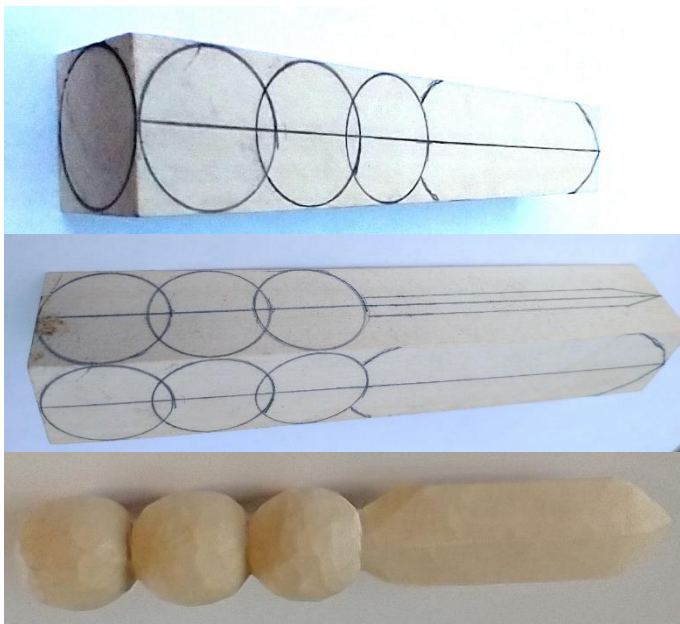


**Oklahoma City Woodcarvers Club - Beginner Woodcarvers Project**

Pattern for letter Opener Knife carved from a 1X1X6 inch piece of basswood. Done by drawing a centerline on 2 adjacent sides of the 6" length. Then draw a circle using a quarter on the 1"X1" end which will be the handle. Then draw 3 slightly overlapping circles along the same sides with the center lines to form the handle. Then draw a point on one side and notches on the same side at the handle. Then draw a line 1/8" on either side of the remaining center line to delineate the blade thickness. Here is a picture.
